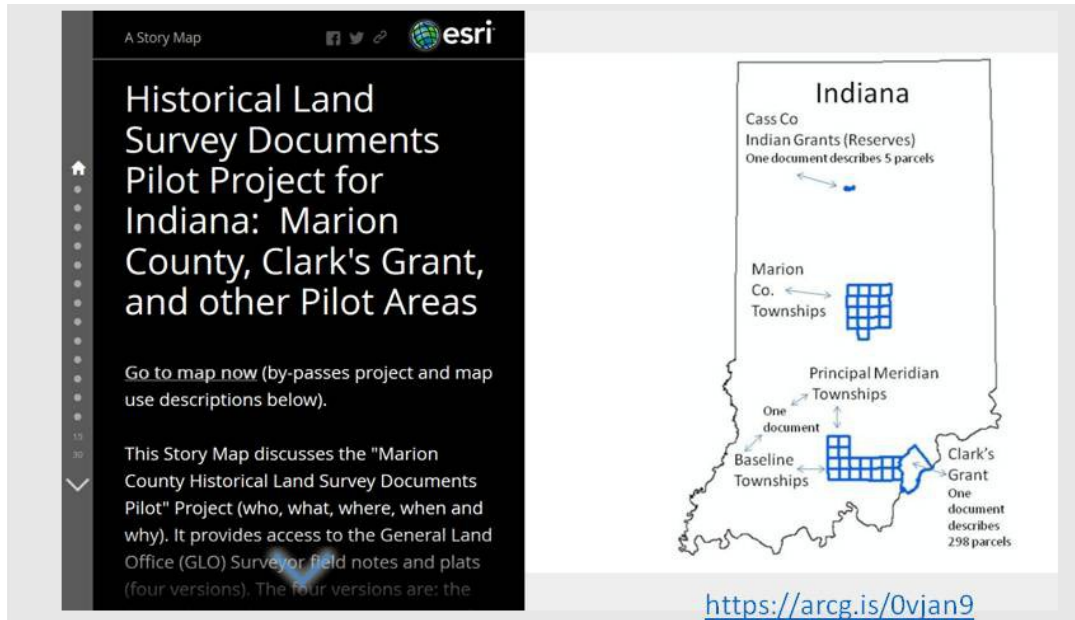




FISA Annual Meeting

The Marion County Pilot Project goal was to research, locate, digitize, process and make publicly available the four versions of the historical General Land Office (GLO), land survey field notes and plats using a Geographic Information System (GIS), a web-based mapping system.

The Indiana State Archives staff have been integral in accessing documents not previously available. Join us on April 9th to learn more about the project and how it will be used.
